



GoNetwork Prayer Guide: September, 2026

This month, we're using the Lord's Prayer as our missional lens to pray for GoNetwork local and regional missional cohorts. We pray to the Lord for growth in their Gospel encouragement of one another, for the building of relational trust with one another, for the sparking of their collaboration with each other, and for the spurring on of each other in mission action.

MONDAY – “Our Father who art in heaven, hallowed be Your Name”

As we lift our prayers to our Heavenly Father, we ask God to do what only He can do especially over what we cannot fix or change. We pray that God would cause His name to be hallowed where it is not yet hallowed.

Scripture To Pray:

“I will sanctify my great name... and the nations shall know that I am the LORD, declares the Lord God, when I am sanctified in you before their eyes.” Ezekiel 36:23

“God is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us.” Ephesians 3:20

Heavenly Father, You do immeasurably more than we can ask or imagine! May Your name be holy among us always in all that we are and do! Set us apart in such a way that others may always see You magnified in us. Empower our encouragement in the abundance of Your grace. Teach us how to trust each other. Gift us with a spirit of collaboration that the Holy Spirit can use as a catalyst to ignite new Gospel outreach in our communities.

TUESDAY – “Your Kingdom come”

When we pray for “God’s Kingdom to come,” we are praying for God to rule in the fullness of His authority over us and the world. With this in mind, praying “Thy Kingdom Come” focuses our attention on at least two things. First, on the Great Commission mission of God (Gospel proclamation). And second on the Great Commandment formation of Christ-likeness in us (Discipleship Growth).

Scripture To Pray:

“He has delivered us from the domain of darkness and transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.” Colossians 1:13-14

“The kingdom of God is not a matter of eating and drinking but of righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.” Romans 14:17

By Your Spirit, Father, open doors of opportunity for partnerships in the Gospel that extend and further Your Kingdom and its advancement. As cohorts meet, form their discipleship in the fullness of Christ’s character always reflecting His Gospel heart and as a people of prayer. Inspire their creativity and courage to walk through the doors Your Spirit opens for them to proclaim the Gospel so that many are saved and come to a knowledge of the truth.

WEDNESDAY – Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven”

“Thy will be done” can sound like a decree requiring our submission, but in the truest sense of the Old Testament, its meaning is closer to *“Let what gives You delight be done.”* That makes this petition one of seeking alignment with what delights and pleases God. That can powerfully change the perspective with which we pray. Try it this month.

Scripture To Pray:

“For this is the will of My Father, that everyone who looks on the Son and believes in Him should have eternal life, and I will raise him up on the last day.” John 6:40

“You open your hand and satisfy the delight of every living thing.” Psalm 145:16

Heavenly Father, as cohorts of missionally minded Jesus-followers gather together, give them a clear sense of what delights You in their gathering, in their relating to one another, in their collaborating together and in their mutual mission adventures inspired by the Holy Spirit.

THURSDAY - “Give us this day our daily bread”

This is not a petition for security but a prayer for enough. Think of Israel in the wilderness as God supplied manna each day to feed them while also instructing them to only collect what they needed for the day. God was teaching them that they could trust and rely upon Him. When we are given a “God-sized” vision that seems impossible for us to accomplish, we only ever need to ask enough for today to begin, trusting that His provision for tomorrow will indeed come tomorrow.

Scripture To Pray:

“Therefore, do not be anxious about tomorrow, for tomorrow will be anxious for itself. Sufficient for the day is its own trouble.” Matthew 6:34

“God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that having all sufficiency in all things at all times, you may abound in every good work.” 2 Corinthians 9:8

Father, we don’t need to amass all we need before we begin. We don’t need to know everything we will ever need to learn to start. We don’t need all the people we imagine are required to accomplish the task. You are our rich supply! We can rely and depend upon You! You are the one who multiplies whatever we can offer! Thank you for today’s provision. Thank You, that You will supply all our needs in Christ Jesus. Lead us boldly to say “Yes” when You open doors for Your mission for us. Let us step courageously forward, following Your Spirit’s lead.

FRIDAY – “And forgive us our sins as we forgive those who sin against us”

If God’s mission is to bring His loving grace, mercy, and forgiveness through Jesus Christ to the world, then for us, to join Him on His mission means that we are called to be a people of grace, mercy, and forgiveness. Let’s pray for God’s mercy and forgiveness to reign everywhere the Lord leads us, and with everyone with whom our lives touch.

Scripture To Pray:

“Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you.”

Ephesians 4:32

“Bearing with one another and, if one has a complaint against another, forgiving each other; as the Lord has forgiven you, so you must also forgive.” Colossians 3:13

Dearest Jesus, in our sin, we believe that we never enough, that we are failures who cannot succeed or change, that we are unable to accomplish anything of any significant good. We are broken in our living and hindered by our failures because of the sins we have committed in the past. But in Jesus, you have set us free from all of that and made us new! Empowered by the freedom of Your mercy to us send us forth as a people of grace who are quick to free others, leading them to Jesus with the same forgiveness that we ourselves have received.

SATURDAY – “Lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil”

Asking God to “deliver us” is asking Him to rescue us from the grasp of what grips us. Whether that’s a temptation, an attack of the evil one, or a time of testing that is overwhelming us. Through it all, we ask God to reveal how He is present with us and at work in that circumstance for our good even as St. Paul writes, “He works all things together for the good of those who love him...” Whatever is too much, too hard, too difficult, or blocking his Gospel - name it, pray it, and ask God to make a way around, or through, or over what is gripping you, or even to remove it all together.

Scripture To Pray:

“Watch and pray that you may not enter temptation. The spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak.”

Mark 14:38

“But the Lord is faithful. He will establish you and guard you against the evil one.” 2 Thessalonians 3:3

Spirit of God, lead Your missionary people together in collaboration, trust, and in Your Gospel mission. Father, as You rescued Your people Israel, making a way where there was no way so that they could pass through the Red Sea on dry land to safety; so go before us and meet us at every challenge, potential detour, and obstacle standing in the way of your Gospel advancement. Whatever the source or purpose of our testing—use it for our good and for Your mission. Bend even every hindrance and temptation of the evil one to Your will and bring Your salvation through Jesus Christ to all!

“For Yours is the Kingdom, power, and glory forever and ever! Amen!”
